Western Idaho Fair

Several club members are participating in the fair classes. If you didn't have a chance to enter the driving or halter classes, maybe you'd like to watch from the grandstand and encourage your friends! Here's a general schedule for the classes available for miniatures:

Light Horse Driving begins at 1 p.m. on Tuesday, August 25, with the Fun Day contests. Section C is for horses 40" and under, and there are many offerings for both single horses and teams. The courses include Canadian Maze, Pole Bending, Trail Challenge, and Harness Challenge. Then at 4 p.m., events are Pleasure Driving-Turnout, Pleasure Driving-Working, and Pleasure Driving-Reinsmanship. Pleasure Driving-Junior is offered for two youth age groups, and Pleasure Driving –Senior is offered for drivers 55 and over. The last event for the day is the Musical Free Style Driving.

Obstacle Classes are on Wednesday, August 26, starting at 10 a.m. with junior and senior drivers first on the prescribed course, then Gamblers Choice. Barrel Racing and Trotter (Sulky) Races complete the day.

<u>The Registered Light Horse Show</u> begins at noon on Friday, August 28. Miniature/Pony classes are first, grouped by age and gender. Trail classes are from 1 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. (In Hand for Miniature Horses). After 4:45 p.m., Showmanship classes will start. Our club is sponsoring two Halter trophies: one for High Point Miniature Gelding, 4 years and older, and one for High Point Miniature Mare, 4 years and older. Karen and Scott Gilworth are sponsoring a High Point Miniature Horse Award for Halter, Showmanship, and In-Hand Trail combined points.
