Old Business:

*Christmas Party/Awards Banquet: December 3rd at 1 pm. The location is the Golden Dragon in Caldwell. \$5 for members and \$10 for non members. Gift exchange \$10 max. If you want to participate in the gift exchange, you need to bring a gift.
