## January 18, 2018 Minutes

at Sunrise Cafe in Middleton, ID, 6:30 p.m. President Maria Redinger called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

November's minutes were reviewed and approved by the club. Felicia motioned to approve and Jane seconded.

Lynne gave the treasurer's report.

Year end balance was \$4,657.98. Receivables were \$50.00, which was the club's cash-on-hand deposited. The other \$50.00 that accounts for the clubs cash-on-hand went to Valerie because the club's by-laws state that the secretary should maintain \$50.00 in petty cash for club expenses, supplies, etc. This made the ending bank balance for January \$4,607.98. It was noted that Valerie also has a copy of the audit approval for 2017. A motion was made by Pam to accept the Treasurer's report, Felicia seconded.

#### **Old Business**

Banquet: A new place is needed since the Golden Dragon has shut down; some ideas were the Jade Garden on the Boulevard, Idaho Pizza, Cold Mountain Creek in Emmett, Mr. Vee's on Tenth, Canton Cafe in Caldwell. Other than that everybody likes the system in which it runs and the awards (and pony names)!

Review of the Points System: Possible changes of the point value system have been brought up, so a committee was made which now includes: Lois, Felicia, Heather, Maria, and Valerie. Since clinics and shows are getting dates set up it was said that all changes need to be done by next meeting.

Birt Arena dates for shows/clinics: The club has had the dates of June 9th, September 15th and October 20th saved at Al Birt arena until decisions were made to keep all of them or not and what for. It was discussed and Felicia made a motion to move the show to June 9th and have a driving clinic/driving playday on September 15th. It was seconded by Jamey and then amended by Donna saying we would also keep our October 20th date for an in-hand only playday.

A show committee was made up, consisting of : Maria Redinger, Donna Bernardelli, Jamey Robbins, and Felicia Humpherys.

New Arena Venues: Lyle and Stacy Toresdahl came to the meeting and said that their arena, on Sand Hollow Rd, is available if it was something that would fit our needs. It's 60x120 feet, not totally enclosed but with mesh on the East and West ends, doesn't have a lot of parking, but could probably fit us comfortably. 4-H'ers have steers there in the Spring, but availability is pretty much open. There are no arena lights and a portable bathroom would be something to think about for possible events. Prices may vary as the owners are new to this game.

Nampa Sanctioned Show awards: The decision to choose what the awards for our club's sponorships would be was tabled at the last meeting and this time decided that for both the High Point Youth B Mini and AMHA Amateur Level One would be a harness bag. Jane made a motion to accept and Pam seconded.

Felicia had a receipt for an ink catridge that she had to buy for printing last year's newsletters and wanted to be reimbursed the \$22.xx. Pam made a motion to accept and Heather seconded.

Riata Riders sent a thank you note to our club for helping them support their IQHA Horse bowl team and Hippology team. The card will be in the secretary's box.

It was mentioned that the Mountain West club wants to know about our clinic dates so that they can attend!

#### **New Business:**

Warm-Up shows: Des Arab has their first one on February 10th at the High Desert Station, ISHSA is February 16th at Birt's, and the WHIPS has their Desensitizing clinic on February 24th at Birt's. (Same day as the ISHSA Year End Awards, but will be done by 4pm.) Hope to see you there!

Club clinics: It was decided to have a driving clinic earlier in the day on September 16th before the driving playday began. Other ideas were to also have a therapy horse clinic, one about showmanship, harnessing, points sheets, etc.

Pam also has some Lana Grieve Star Point Horsemanship DVD's that she is willing to lend out. There are also YouTube videos and these videos/discs cover A LOT!!!

Pam has calendars! They are \$12.50, so let her know if you want one!

Donna spoke on behalf of the WHIPS club to let us know that they are willing to work with the mini group on flexibility of rules, etc. (To a certain safety standard.) for clinics and shows because they want more of our attendance! A Dressage driving clinic could possibly be on March 24th and a show on the 25th, but Donna will get an affirmative on that.

Maria mentioned she had the receipt for the trophies for the End of the year Awards and it was a total of: \$104.27. Pam motioned for the club to pay her back and Felicia seconded.

Katherine brought up the idea of having a raffle that continues for more than one show until we pick a show to give it away at and she would donate it. (Something to think about.)



The Treasure Valley Whips Carriage Driving Club is offering their wildly popular bomb-proofing and desensitizing playday once again in their new format, in hopes of helping everyone have more fun and to enhance safety. For access to the indoor arena we are dividing the day into T one hour sections starting at 9:00 am. Participants will sign up for a particular hour or hours. We will limit the number of participants per hour, so that everyone signed up for that hour can spend the entire hour in the indoor arena. No more waiting in long lines to get into the indoor arena! You do not have to pay per horse. Linda Kaye Hollingsworth-Jones is our official ringmaster who will be keeping things moving in the arena, and will be available for assistance if requested. Pre-registration via e-mail is preferred. You can make your reservation for a particular hour or hours and pay on the day of the event. You will then know what time to be there, and won't have to wait around to get into the arena. Depending upon the weather we will also have some homb-proofing areas outside around the grounds.
