Stalls/Tack -\$75 for the event or \$30/day – reservations to be made online @ fordidahocenter.com/reservations. 1 horse per stall max. Shavings may be purchased thru the Ford Idaho Horse Center for \$10 per bale. Early arrivals and late departures are allowed at a rate of \$17 per stall per night

Grounds Fee- \$30 per day if not stalled.

Ribbons will be given for 1-6 in all classes *We will be giving away prizes such as a Yeti Cooler, Andis Clippers, etc.

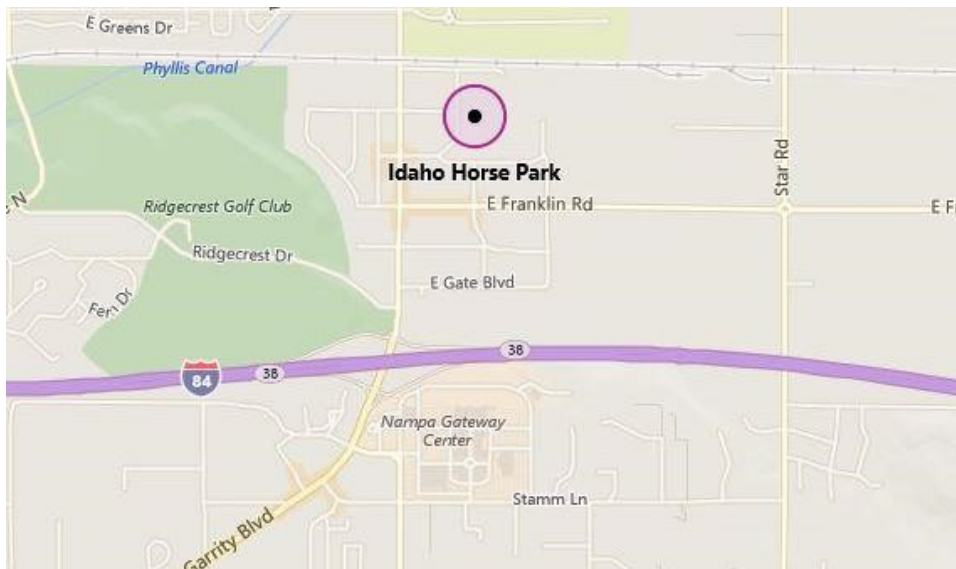
Directions:

Interstate I84 westbound from Boise: Take Exit 38 and continue right approximately one-half mile to the traffic light. Continue straight through the traffic light and drive one-quarter mile and turn right into the Ford Idaho Center's parking lot.

Interstate I84 eastbound from Caldwell and Ontario Oregon: Take Exit 38 and turn left and drive approximately one-half mile to the traffic light. Continue straight through the traffic light and drive one-quarter mile and turn right into the Ford Idaho Center's parking lot.

Franklin Road (Meridian): Continue west on Franklin Road past Star Road approximately three quarters of a mile and turn right into the parking lot (entrance past the Service Entry). This parking lot has the most handicapped parking spaces.

State Street (Highway 44), Chinden Boulevard, and Cherry Lane: Continue west past Star Road for one mile and turn left onto Ford Idaho Center Blvd. Continue south (three miles Highway 44, 2 miles Chinden)

Rules:

- NO REFUND ON STALL FEES
- Refunds will be given only upon receipt of veterinarian certificate for the event.
- NO refunds for missed classes: It shall be the exhibitor's responsibility to watch the progression of the show.
- Checks returned for non-sufficient funds shall incur a \$35 return check fee.
- Ring procedure: the management shall expect all exhibitors to have familiarized themselves with the official rule book of AMHA. Any horse that becomes a threat to an exhibitor, audience or other animal may be asked to leave the ring, or to be removed from the show grounds.
- Two-minute gate rule: Once the class is called, the gate steward will begin timing for all entries to enter.
- It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to barn areas are a management courtesy – not mandatory.
- Changing Classes: Exhibitors must fill out a class change form which must be done before or after the show or during breaks. Must be done before the desired class enters the ring. Payment or arrangement for payment to be done at this time.
- Gate Holds: Gate holds MUST be given to the gate person 4 classes in advance and in writing. Gate holds will be for a maximum of 2 minutes expect for harness changes which will be allowed 5 minutes.
- Amateur/Youth Classes: Amateur and Youth must provide a copy of their current Amateur or Youth card. Applications for Amateur and Youth memberships will be available in the show office.
- Lunch/Dinner Breaks: Will be left to the discretion of the judges and show management. However, we will not break until a division is complete. Example- if we are on a yearling mare class, lunch will not be held until after the Grand Championship class, etc.
- Back numbers: No back numbers will be issued until entries are paid in full.
- Facilities: Indoor arena does not have stalls located inside. Absolutely no lounging in the show arena. Stalls are located south of the arena. Wash racks are available. Please provide your own hose. Please do not wash in the aisles, roadway or other areas. The coverall will be open to warm up. Please be aware of your surroundings and respect other people using the coverall. Practice jumps will be made available to use.
- Dogs are allowed only in barns and RV areas and **must be on a leash**. No dogs allowed in the arena or other buildings. Please clean up after your animals.
- No horses in the RV area.
- No smoking in stalls or buildings
- Stalls: \$75 for the Thurs-Sat night, early and late departures are allowed with an additional fee. Reservations to be made online @ fordidahocenter.com/reservations. 1 horse per stall max. Unruly horses will be charged extra. Showing out of trailer will be allowed however horses cannot be tied to trailers overnight or left on trailers overnight.

Copies of registration papers must accompany entry and be up to date. (front and back of papers are needed.) If said horse is a senior stallion, a copy of the Senior Stallion Verification report must be sent in. Copy of Amateur/Youth card needs to accompany entry.

- No horses allowed on concourse expect during measuring times.
- Any Entry or class mailed will constitute an official entry and payment must be made.
- This AMHA sanctioned show is open to any horse registered with the AMHA whose exhibitor is able to prove valid registration
- Entries close on and must be postmarked by May 17, 2019.
- Post Entries will be accepted.
- Any exhibitor with Special Needs is welcome to participate in all shows
- Out of State horses will need a current health certificate and negative Coggins
