Minutes of April 9th, 2019, at Mr. V's Restaurant in Caldwell, ID

Maria brought the meeting to order at 6:34 P.M.

Treasurer's report: Beginning balance: \$4,854.59. Receivables were: \$10.00 from Donna Gramarossa's membership, \$10.00 from Tess Eastman's membership, and \$9.65 from Janet Fries for club swag. Expenses were: \$42.40 to Donna Bernardelli for VSC flowers. Cash on hand is \$50.00 with the secretary and \$50.00 with the treasurer. This month ending balance is \$4,841.84. Last month the club had authorized to pay the amount of \$227.74 to GoDaddy.com to keep our website running. We found out they don't take checks and Pam MacFarlane paid with her credit card. Heather made a motion to accept the report and pay back Pam the \$227.74. Robin seconded that motion and the motion passed by the club.

April secretary minutes were reviewed. Everyone agreed there were no changes to be made, so Heather made a motion to accept them as they were on the website and Robin seconded. Motion passed by the club.

Treasurer's report: Beginning balance: \$4,839.59. Payments were in memberships of the amount of \$59.26. And Expenses were \$227.74 from GoDaddy, as well as \$227.74 to Pam MacFarlane who paid GoDaddy when they wouldn't take the club's check. Somebody was going to Pam to see if she knew why they suddenly accepted the check, and to see what it would take to get it back since the club had already voided it, or if it's just left alone and we end up paying for the next four years. Cash on hand is still total of \$100.00 which brings the ending balance to \$4,543.37.

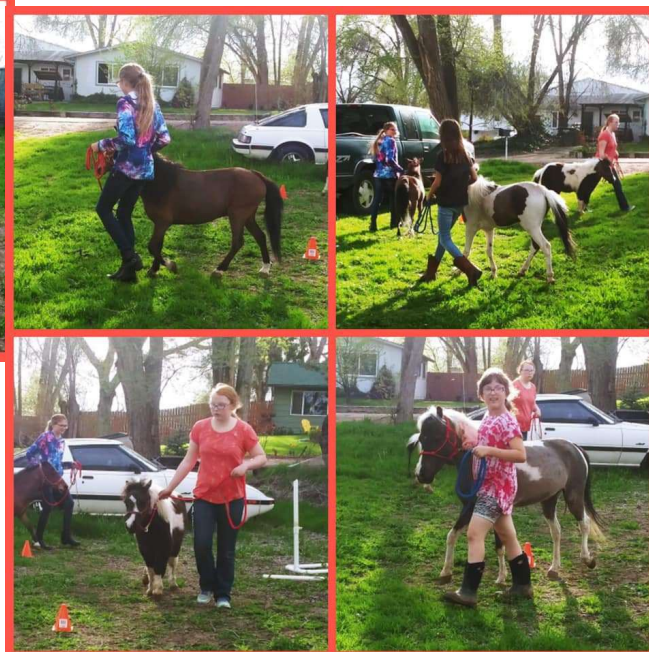
