Minutes of January 9th, 2020 at The Original Sunrise Café in Middleton, ID.

Maria brought the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

Heather motioned to accept the treasurer's report and Jamey seconded. The motion passed by the club.

Those present voted to vote on the matter at the meeting. There was some ending discussion on the matter before it was put to a vote. The vote passed to amend "all equine 38 inches and under" to "all equine up to 48 inches".

-End of the year Banquet- Everyone seemed to agree that the location and catering idea was great! Huge thank you to the Banquet committee and to those who could make it!

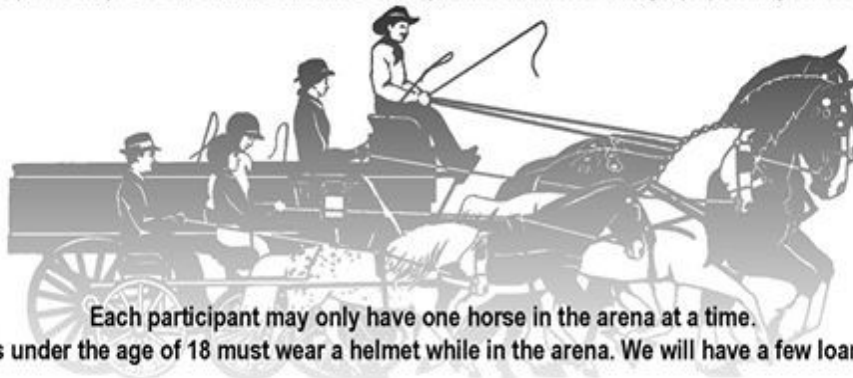
The TVW Carriage Driving Club is continuing our popular bomb-proofing and desensitizing playday in our new format. The goal is to help everyone have fun and enhance safety.

Cost is \$20 per participant, per hour. There is no per horse fee.

You may bring more than 1 horse and split the time. You may also purchase more than 1 hour of time. At the end of each hour we will clear the arena and adjust equipment before having the next group enter.

Payment is due when you arrive. Registration, payment, and liability release form must be completed before any participant enters any arena, inside or out.

Paid participants may use the outside obstacles all day, at no additional charge (depending on the weather.)



Each participant may only have one horse in the arena at a time.

Participants under the age of 18 must wear a helmet while in the arena. We will have a few loaner helmets.

Horses can be led in-hand, line-driven or ridden. No carts or carriages. No ponying a second horse.

You must be able to maintain control of your horse at all times.

Ring Stewards will have final say on any safety issues and will be available for assistance if requested.

We will limit the number of participants in the arena per hour to 15.
