Idaho Miniature Horse Club General Meeting Minutes

Minutes of February 13th, 2020, at The Original Sunrise Café in Middleton, ID.

Maria Redinger brought the meeting to order at 6:33 p.m.

January secretary minutes were reviewed. Felicia motioned to accept the minutes as they were published, and Jessie seconded it. Motion passed by the club.

Treasurer's report: There was no report because the treasurer couldn't make it at the last minute. She did let us know that she had paid the club's dues to AMHA, AMHR, ISHSA, and the Horse Council as the motions to do so were approved in January.

OLD BUSINESS

-Website Changes: Pam was unable to make it to the meeting, but she had sent in some information and inquiries as to what the club would want on the website. The second paragraph on the website's home page is where it used to include the height sentence of 38 inches and under, but that has been recently changed and Pam wanted to know what the club thought of this wording:

"We meet regularly, publish a newsletter, and sponsor annual awards for youth, adults, and equine. We hold clinics with expert clinicians, and we conduct play days to provide practice and encouragement in a relaxed atmosphere. Miniatures measure 38" and under, and the club is recognized by both AMHA and AMHR. As an open club, the horses do not have to be registered. Because of increased interest in small ponies, we also welcome equine 48" and under to join the club and participate in activities. We invite you to become a member and experience rewarding opportunities to strengthen your relationship with miniature horses and small ponies."

Some feedback on that was to include the hands equivalent measurement of 48 inches (which would be 12 hands), and to also list all the affiliations that include AMHR like ASPC/ASPR/NSPPR etc. like how it is on the ASPC website. Pam also included that she deleted the part that said our club offered a gelding incentive since that hasn't been done in a long time. Pam also explained more in depth what "open" meant.

-Club horse hats: Maria has the red pom-pom hats if you payed for them and haven't received them. There may also be extra if you would like to purchase one please contact Maria.

NEW BUSINESS

-Activities committee: Apparently the committee has met, and they have many ideas for a fun year! None of them were present so it will be a surprise until the next meeting!

-Horse Expo: Jamey was not present, but she has met and spoken with those in charge, so details are still falling into place. Stay tuned!

-Pet Expo: April 25th is the Pet Expo. Maria and Christine are trying to get their 4-H clubs involved and will have more information soon to see if the club can help or be a part of it as well.

-WISK: Jessie is looking for class sponsorships and if you would like to help individually contact Jessie. She was also letting the club know, since we did sponsor classes a couple of years ago. She was asking for sponsorships to be \$25 per class. Those at the meeting decided to table anymore discussion in hopes there would be more members present.

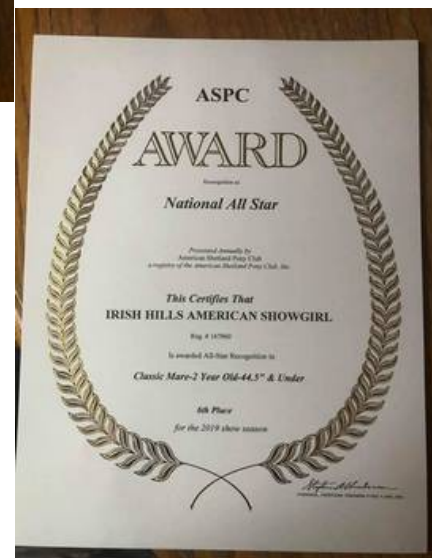
